

Clearing Saved Passwords and Form Data in Firefox:


Clearing Saved Form & Search History

1. Click the **Library** menu and go to **History**, then **Clear Recent History...**.





2. Click on the drop down box to the right of **Time range to clear**: and select **Everything**. Then, check **Browsing & Download History**, **Cookies**, **Active Logins**, **Cache and Form & Search History**. Click on **Clear Now**.




Viewing and Deleting Saved Passwords


The Firefox Password Manager securely stores your usernames and passwords.

1. At the top-right of the Firefox window, click on the **Firefox menu** button and then click **Options**.

2. Select the Privacy & Security panel. Click Saved Logins... and the Password Manager will open.



- **To see the passwords you have saved**, click Show Passwords. When you close the window, your passwords will be automatically hidden.
- Use the search box to find a particular website or username. Click the X in the search bar to clear your search and see the full list again.
- To remove a username and password, select it from the list and click Remove.
- **To remove all stored usernames and passwords**, click Remove All. After confirming this choice, all of your stored usernames and passwords will be deleted.
