Public Participation

At each regular and special open meeting, members of the public and district employees may comment to or ask questions of the School Board, subject to reasonable constraints.

Per Board Policy 2:230, individuals appearing before the Board are expected to follow these guidelines:

1. Address the Board only at the appropriate time as indicated on the agenda and when recognized by the Board President.
2. Identify oneself and be brief. Comments shall be limited to 5 minutes.
3. Observe the Board President's decision to shorten public comment to conserve time and give the maximum number of individuals an opportunity to speak.
4. Observe the Board President's decision to determine procedural matters regarding public participation.
5. Conduct oneself with respect and civility toward others and otherwise abide by Board policy 8:30, Visitors and Conduct on School Property.

Petitions or written correspondence to the Board shall be presented to the Board in the next regular Board packet.

We appreciate your public comments and your cooperation in following these guidelines.
