Antioch Upper Grade School 2018-2019

- Planning for a master schedule change
 - Met 5 times
 - Current Stakeholders: Teachers, social worker, administration
 - Minutes per subject area, honors classes for Math, Reading and Science staffing, student and parent involvement, encore offernings
- Planning for the implementation of a 6th grade academy
 - o Co-leaders David Shepherd and Joe Koeune
 - Met 3 times
 - Interviewed a principal from Minnesota
 - o Gather information around academic, social/emotional needs, scheduling, community engagement and staffing
- Implement Advisory schedule
 - Each staff member will be assigned to a group of students
 - Date in September, November, February and April
 - Team building, Goal setting, Student check-in, PBIS and Second Step boosters
- Pilot grading policy with a cohort of teachers
 - Met 5 times
 - Summative, Formative, Practice, Performance
 - Next step determine the type of assignments for each category
 - Final planning for updated grading policy
- Implement changes to "Success Period"
 - Student work time, intervention, enrichment, reading time, goal setting, Achieve 3000 (support ELA), PBIS/Second Step boosters

Antioch Upper Grade School 2019-2020

- Implement master schedule changes
 - Implement new schedule with a focus on ELA minutes
 - Implement Encore Changes
 - Implement Honors Science
- Implement 6th grade academy
 - Provide specific supports to help students to transition to a middle school setting
- Implement updated grading policy
 - Universal grading policy for all teachers and subjects

 - 3 comments out of 20 mentioned a concern around enough time
- 4. How many were AUGS where ELA is so short?
 - Master Schedule Committee planning in 2018-2019
- 5. Supplemental Writing/apart from ELA What classes?
 - Supplemental writing resource will be in ELA Grades 3-8, Writing expectations will be
 K-8 all content areas
- 6. Writing/Language work books
 - Implementation at AUGS 2018-2019, ELA teachers developing them

 - At this time it is difficult to work beyond current master schedule, for 2018-2019 Leveled ELA and Math Classes and independent enrichment opportunities offered in Success class
- 3. The Guidebook is great! I agree too long for parents to read.
 - Parent version created in 2018-2019
- 4. Who else uses FastBridge? Are others moving away from AIMSWEB?
 - Fastbridge Submission Form Curriculum Oversight Committee (under research section)
- 5. Specifically at AUGS- Will AP's be running a "Team Meeting" at each grade level?
 - AP's do attend and will continue to attend Team Meetings
- 6. Where all team members meet at a "mutual IPST" weekly to discuss their teams students/behaviors?
 - Weekly Team Meetings are not IPST meetings. There are two different meetings.
- 7. Interventions taking place/need to take place
 - Interventions take place, we will be looking to expand resources available to staff
- 8. AP's are supposed to serve as the Instructional Leaders more specifically. Hoping they can run these meetings. As a board we agreed to hire a dean to free up time for AP's to meet with teams and do more instructional duties.
