## **Seating of New Board Member**

Board President Tamara Neumann administered the oath of office to newly appointed board member Lori Linck.

#### **Personnel**

The Board approved 5 appointments and 3 resignations. Administrator contracts and ESP hourly rate increases were also approved.

### Superintendent's Report

Dr. Buchanan congratulated Mr. Starck-King and the district staff for successful implementation of the new online registration and residency verification process. To date 93% of the District 34 students' residency has been verified. Dr. Buchanan reminded the Board of the August 7, 2013 Board of Education Safety Committee Meeting and the upcoming early September Board of Education Strategic Plan Committee Meeting.
