Recognition

The Board recognized the following accomplishments: the Geography Bee state qualifier; AUGS published student poets; AUGS 8th grade boys' volleyball team; AUGS Battle of the Books winners; and the Science Olympiad winners and sponsors.

Presentation

Nate Pratt's 2nd grade class presented a video of their 21st Century classroom. Paul Starck-King shared the PMA 5-year projection. Superintendent's Report

Action Items

The Board approved the award of the AUGS Sidewalk and Paving Project to Payne & Donan, Inc. in the amount of \$317,028. They also approved the award of the Sequoit Creek Highview Drive culvert replacement to Berger Excavating in the amount of \$433,000. Additional summer custodial/maintenance staff were approved. The Board also approved the physical therapist contract with Dena Denny Physical Therapy.
