Accepted Documents for Proof of Residency

To verify residency, you must present proof of residency within School District 34 by providing <u>one</u> document from category I and <u>two</u> documents from category II.

Category I (one document required):

Homeowners:

Most recent property tax bill

Current mortgage statement or mortgage papers/closing papers (for closing within last 60 days) **Renters**:

Signed and dated lease and proof of last month's payment, e.g., canceled check or receipt Letter of Residence from Landlord in Lieu of Lease form and proof of last month's payment, e.g., canceled check or receipt - form is available on the district's website Letter of Residence to Be Used When the Person Seeking to Enroll a Student is Living with a District Resident form - form is available on the district's website

Category II (two documents required):

Each document must have the current address:

Driver's license

Vehicle registration

Voter registration

Most recent credit card bill

Current public aid card

Current homeowners/renters insurance policy and premium payment receipt

Most recent gas, electric and/or water bill (cell phone bills are not accepted)

Receipt for moving van rental
