

Pad concerns

The technology department has seen an increase in headphone plugs breaking off in the iPads. iOS Update

Apple has released the new operating system, iOS 17, which the Technology Department will be pushing out to all devices soon. If you notice a student's iPad is asking to be updated, please push the button to allow it. It may ask to be updated at night, which is fine as long as the iPad is connected to the internet. This update should help with certain program issues that we are seeing in the district

The district will send the command to force the update, but students/staff may interrupt the download. If this happens, the students/staff should manually install the update.
